ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2024

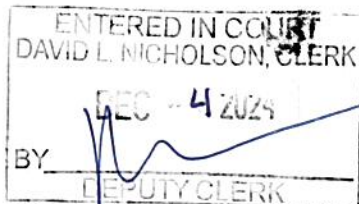
This Court having previously entered an Order regarding scheduling (3-25-2024), and in the interest of efficiency,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that where cases are re-scheduled due to the Court being in a jury trial, the Court will assign a "Proposed New Court Date". To inform the parties of the Proposed New Court Date, the Court will post a list of the Proposed New Court Date for the day's docket on the courtroom door and on the Court's website:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if one or both parties have a conflict with the Proposed New Court Date, the party or parties with a conflict shall be present at the Court's next scheduled motion hour to voice their objection to the proposed date and obtain a satisfactory date.

Finally, **IT IS ORDERED THAT**, if the parties do not appear at the next motion hour, this Court will assume that there is not a conflict with the Proposed New Court Date. The Court will finalize the hearing date in its calendar; enter appropriate transportation orders; and send a scheduling order to all parties.
